MODEL ACTIVITIES

- 1. Both indoor and outdoor model sets will operate on Saturday and Sunday.
- 2. Indoor sets are located on the lower level of the Campus Center rooms 175 and 176.
- In the event that the weather becomes extreme (a hurricane) the auditorium of the Campus Center will be utilized as a substitute location.
- 4. Locations: (1) the Campus Center; (2) the west pond location (3) the walls of the east side of the campus chapel
- 5. Models pose:

Saturday from 9:00 AM through lunch until 5:00 PM.

Sunday from 9:00 AM until 11:00 AM.

MODEL RELEASE

- 1. Models sign a limited "Model Release" granting permission to participating NECCC attendees to use images taken at the NECCC 2015 Conference for personal use only.
- 2. Personal use is **expressly limited** to camera club activities as well as personal web sites. There are **no exceptions** to this granting of permission.
- 3. A photograph of a conference model cannot be offered for sale, even at a very inexpensive price on sites such as *Smug Mug*.
- 4. All models have been told that they will not sign any model release. If the photographer pressures them, models are told to refer that photographer to **Skip Hoyt**, **Chairperson of the Model Committee**.

GUIDELINES FOR SUBMITTING IMAGES OF MODELS

- 1. Photographers should send the Photoshopped images with the model's name to the individual model.
- 2. All the models will have their name, email, and contact information available throughout the weekend.
- 3. Model information will be on a card posted in the area of the models where they are posing, by the changing room, by the indoor-set ups near CC175-176.
- 4. Images must be sized to 768 pixels in height by 1024 pixels in width, a maximum resolution of (dpi 240).
- 5. Please feel free to send as many tweaked digital images as you wish to the models.
