CANON WILL PRINT YOUR PHOTO

Canon is again offering a free print of your image printed on a Canon Printer. Bring an edited image file ready to print on a USB drive to the Canon vendor table. A representative from the Canon Pixma Printer Group is available to answer your questions. Your print file should be sized to be 12 x 18 inch or less at 300 pixels per inch. Save file as TIFF, PSD, or JPEG and the color space should be Adobe RGB or SRGB. Save the print file in a folder labeled CANON on a USB Flash Drive with your name on the drive.
