Guests can purchase a meal plan for the Dining Commons during registration or as individual meals at the Dining Commons. *Meal plans are only valid at the Dining Commons: meal cards will not work in the Blue Wall or any other Campus Center or retail eateries.*

- Five Prepaid Meals (\$69.00) – includes: dinner on Friday; breakfast, lunch and dinner on Saturday; breakfast on Sunday; valid only at the Dining Commons.
- Four Prepaid Meals (\$52.00) – includes: breakfast, lunch and dinner on Saturday; breakfast on Sunday; valid only at the Dining Commons.
- Worcester Commons individual, non-prepaid, cash prices:
  - Breakfast – \$9.50
  - Lunch – \$12.50
  - Dinner – \$15.50
