

## Winter 2012-2013 Interclub Print Competition

The winter 2012-2013 interclub print competition was held on January 30th at the Cape Cod Viewfinders in Harwich, Massachusetts. Peter Selig, MNEC, Cape Cod Viewfinder's NECCC representative, served as the event organizer and coordinator. Serving as judges for this competition were: Ken Wiedermann, MNEC, Alan Trugman, and David Jordan. Ken became interested in photography in his early teens, where, under his father's tutelage, he learned to process black and white prints, and was helped to develop his compositions with his dad's suggestions for technique, lighting, and subject choice. As a member of Stony Brook Camera Club for over 30 years, he served as Vice President, President, and Black and White Print Chairman. Ken has been extremely successful selling his work through stock agencies, and has been published in numerous venues such as magazines, post cards, calendars, brochures, etc. He has to his credit Vermont Life, Country, and New England Living magazines. Ken has also judged extensively throughout New England and was selected to be a member of the Judging team for the annual Kodak/Boston Globe Photography Contest. Ken has taught photography courses and served NECCC on the equipment committee. Ken is currently a member of Upper Cape Camera Club in Falmouth and the Stony Brook Camera Club of Wrentham.

Alan attended Los Angeles City College and the University of Southern California majoring in Theater. Alan spent 20 years in the entertainment business, working in the costume industry in both television and film. He located to Cape Cod in 1993 and reconnected with his love of photography. He is a juried member of the Cape Cod Art Association in Fine Art Photography and is currently the President of the Cape Cod Art Association Camera Club (CCAACC) in Hyannis. He has exhibited in various local and national shows and has received awards for his work. Alan currently works as a graphic designer.

David, originally from New Jersey, has been active in club competitions. Upon retirement, he re-located to Cape Cod where he served as President of the Cape Cod Viewfinders (CCVF) for seven years. He is a juried member of the Cape Cod Art Association in Fine Art Photography and is currently the President Emeritus of CCVF Camera Club. David won the Print Diversity Award from the PSA Yankee Chapter a few years ago.

The competition went off very smoothly with a team of seven people sharing the work. Janet DiMattia served as paper scorekeeper, with Debbie Owen and Michael Karchmer scoring electronically, and Ron Snider logging the scores on the prints. Suz Karchmer, Robert Slott, and Doris Gage-West served as print runners. Peter Selig, MNEC and Suz Karchmer received the prints, organized their showing and processed their return. Many thanks go to the Cape Cod Viewfinders Camera Club, the members of their NECCC Print Competition Committee, and the judges for carrying out the task of hosting the second competition of the 2012-2013 season.

A total of 173 prints were submitted... 54-class "A", 30-class "B", and 89-Color. Participating were 21 clubs... 12 in class "A", 8 in class "B", and 21 in Color. A total of 25 prints received awards... 9 class "A", 7 class "B" and 9 in Color. The scoring range for class "A" B&W was 17 to 25 points, for class "B" B&W 17 to 24 points, and for Color 18 to 27 points. Clubs that submitted less than their full allotment of four color and four B&W, or that missed the winter competition entirely, are encouraged to submit make-up prints along with their regular prints for the spring competition, to be hosted by the Charter Oak Photographic Society on Monday, April 8, 2013.
